Survey of a road in Waitsfield three rods wide, a line in the centre begins at a large rock two rods east of Gimethon(?) Skinner's Dwelling House, and runs N.  $37^{\circ}$  E. \_ 52 rods, thence N.  $16^{\circ}$  E. \_106 rods to the north end of s[.]d Skinners improvements, thence N.  $15^{\circ}$  8 rods, thence N.  $36^{\circ}$ E. 15 rods, thence N  $18^{\circ}$ E. 7 rods, thence N.  $35^{\circ}$ e. 10 rods, thence N.  $20^{\circ}$ E 12 rods, thence N.  $18^{\circ}$ W. 9 rods, thence N.  $12^{\circ}$ E. 18 rods, thence N.  $21^{\circ}$ E. 20 rods, thence N.  $32^{\circ}$ E. 35 rods, thence N.  $16^{\circ}$  E 14 rods to a Beach Tree marked H standing on the line of the Town of Moretown.---

Surveyed Nov. 21<sup>st</sup> 1826, by Jenison Jones, Surveyor

One hundred and fifty eight rods of the above road on the south end of the same is laid a pent road, with the rights of keeping not to exceed three pairs of Bars or Gates on the same.

Approved Nov. 29<sup>th</sup> 1826.
